There is an average of 15 opioid-related overdoses each week in Kane County. Of these, more than 70 died 2018. The age group with the highest death rate is 25 to 44 years. The average age was 38 years.

Nate Lanthrum, Clinical Director of Lighthouse Recovery will be the presenter. Nate is a certified alcohol and other drug abuse counselor with more than fifteen years of counseling high-risk adolescent and adult clients in both the criminal justice system and private substance abuse treatment.

The presentation will include the prevalence of opioid use in Kane County, the risks of using opioids, and successful treatment modalities that restore the person to a functional life.

County Sheriff Ron Hain will also be present, schedule permitting.
