School Summary

J.B. Nelson Elementary School opened in 1955 and was named in honor of John B. Nelson, a math teacher at Batavia High School who went on to become the school's principal in 1921 and then District superintendent from 1938 to 1962. After retiring, he continued to serve BPS101 by substitute teaching at Batavia High School. JBN is one of six public elementary schools in Batavia. The building underwent construction over the summer of 2023 adding a secure entry vestibule, along with a new front office and conference room.
